+ Finding & Paying for overnight accommodation is your responsibility on these trips.

* The College will make the necessary transport and accommodation arrangements and an additional charge may be levied for these trips.

In addition, the College runs trips into Banbury on some weekday afternoons, and also on a number of weekday evenings. These trips will be scheduled in the weekly bulletins.

The Tour Programme is an integral part of the study abroad experience. While your participation is optional it is highly recommended that you take advantage of the travel opportunities available. Having said this, however, if you are operating on a strict financial budget, be careful not to run yourself short towards the end of the semester.

PROCEDURE: ALL students wishing to go on any of these trips listed on this outline, whether it is for class or – where possible – for their own general interest, must sign the list(s) at Reception by 10.30am each Wednesday prior to the trip(s) concerned. A deposit of £5.00 for EACH trip MUST be paid AT THE TIME OF SIGNING: the money will ONLY be returned to you once you are underway on the trip(s).

The College will pay any admission charges involved **BUT ONLY FOR THOSE STUDENTS WHO HAVE SIGNED UP AND PAID THEIR REQUIRED DEPOSIT(S) FOR THE TRIP(S)** concerned.

If you fail to sign up by the required deadline, but still wish to participate in the offered trip(s) **IF THIS PROVES POSSIBLE** you will be required to pay a non-refundable fee of £10.00 per trip **and** you will also be responsible for payment of any required admission fees that may be involved.

If you have guests staying at the College and would like them to take part in the offered trips, **PLEASE NOTE** Guests are required to pay a non-refundable fee of £5.00 per person per trip for transport. Guests would be responsible for their own admission fees. For extended trips (eg. Edinburgh/Paris) guests would have to pay the full-required costs. (*Depending on availability*)

PLEASE NOTE: TOURS WILL NOT TAKE PLACE UNLESS A MINIMUM NUMBER OF STUDENTS Usually six – FIRSTLY sign up for and SECONDLY go on them.

When on your trips – come to that, at any other time as well – *DO remember the College Photographic Competition.*

It consists of the following categories:

Photo of Wroxton College (inside or out)/ Landscape / Portrait / Architecture /Interior /Miscellaneous

There can be up to SIX entries in total per individual.

An award will be made to the winner in each of the six categories. There will also be an award for the best photograph overall.

The Closing date for entries is 5.00pm Friday 2 May 2014
with the results being announced on the evening of Monday 5th May 2014
